Housekeeping

<u>Signing in and Signing out</u>: THIS IS IMPORTANT, this is our record of attendance. Ministry requires that the **exact time** of arrival and departure is noted. If there is an emergency in the centre and we need to leave the building, we need to know who is here. WE DO NOT WANT TO LEAVE ANYONE BEHIND.

If your child is booked in on our half day or 6-hour school session and you need to drop off your child early or pick them up late, please check that it is okay with us first as we must ensure that we have enough staff for the number of children in attendance. Please do not assume that if you drop off your child late that you can pick them up late as we staff the centre according to your enrolment times.

All early drop offs and late pick-ups will be charged for as follows: Up to 30 minutes over \$5, Up to 1 hour over \$10. The charge is \$1 per minute after 5:30

Have you moved house or changed your telephone number?

Please remember to advise us if you change your address or if any of the telephone contact numbers you have given us change.

This includes your home and mobile numbers plus any contact numbers that you have given us for emergency contacts and other people who are allowed to pick up your child.
